
Week 10

When we got the idea to publish also Dutch laces as in Every week an egden or an insertion, I decided to have a look in my grandmothers patterns. A lot of useable patterns were found: Dutch laces, Torchon, Guipure and so on. I think we will use these paters quite a lot. This is the first one, an edging designed by Mrs. De Jager Meezenbroek. But someone did change it a little bit. Mrs. Spaargaren de Lamaar, who is mentioned on the pattern? I don't know and there is nobody left who can tell me.

You need 19 pairs of bobbins with DMC film de dentelle or similar.





The edge at the top are 2 plaits which cross each other at the outside in a 4-pairs crossing and at the inside are to be connected with the workers of the inner part in a 3-pairs crossing. The tapes on both sides and the blocks are to be worked in cloth stitch. Between the blocks plaits are to be made. In the centre of the blocks the workers go via the plaits to the other side, are to be connected there and go backwards. At the points of the blocks the hanging pair at the outside crosses over to the opposite block.
