
Week 34

The flower in this edging is from a Buckspoint pattern. Buckspoint is an English pointground lace, which is originally from Buckinghamshire.

You need 27 pairs of bobbins with Egyptian cotton 90/2 or similar and 3 pairs of bobbins with a gimp.



Also for this edging the diagram is very important. There you can see how the pairs and the gimps are running.

The filling in the flower is a snowflake made in cloth stitch. See the threaddiagram below. The connection from the flakes to the petals of the flower is shown in the working diagram.
