

Karelian lace in 2 colors

20 pairs of bobbins with linen 50/2, 14 pairs of main color and 6 pairs of contrast color.

The Karelian lace is originally made without a pattern but with striped or checkered fabric on the roll. To make it a bit easier, I have drawn the work schedule to the intended width, so that it can be used as a pricking. However, pins are only placed on the edges and not in the middle. The "pattern" helps to place the pins straight and spaced. It also helps to tension the pairs well, because you can see where the motifs should be in the lace.

The diagram is in the international colorcode: red = whole stitch purple = cloth stitch The fatter lines indicate the pairs in the contrast color.
